

UPVC has been recognised for many years as a durable, low-maintenance and energy-efficient option for conservatories. Now, thanks to advances in recycling, UPVC is also the first-choice material for sustainability. Here's why...

The official life span of UPVC is 35 years, and research shows that 95% of it can be recycled. Not only that but it can be recycled up to 10 times. This means UPVC can be reused, with minimal impact on the environment, for 350 years.

At Eurocell, we're committed to producing high-quality products that reduce our impact on the environment. That's why we're at the forefront of sustainable developments in the UPVC industry.

We recycle around 3 million waste window and conservatory frames every year, which would otherwise go to landfill. We then use some of that material to make new windows and conservatories. And this process is all completed in the UK – reducing CO₂ emissions in the manufacturing process and cutting down travel miles.

Our conservatories and orangeries offer excellent thermal performance too. Their U-value is as little as 0.15 on solid tiled roofs and 1.0 on glazed roofs. That means less heat escapes in winter, and the temperature is regulated in summer. So, your room will be comfortable to use all year round. Plus, you'll save money on heating bills and reduce your carbon footprint.

Our conservatories represent a genuinely sustainable option. So, choosing to buy your UPVC from us is good for your home, your pocket and the environment.





Our orangery roof system is a modern take on a traditional roof design. Combining a traditionally styled external highline cornice with an internal insulated, plastered pelmet.


